7.3 MB) is structured in modules, which can be used independently or together. Delivering all modules is expected to take around 3.5 hours.

The modules include:



- Elevator speech – getting hooked (10 minutes)
- Definitions and concepts – setting the scene (30 minutes)
- Status and supply – urgency for action (30 minutes)
- Drivers and causes of change – cause and effect (20 minutes)
- Consequences of degradation – impacts (30 minutes, if examples are incorporated)
- Responses – ways forward (90 minutes)

By including examples and case studies of business risks and opportunities arising from a company's dependence and/or impact on ecosystem services, the business case for ecosystems can be further strengthened.
