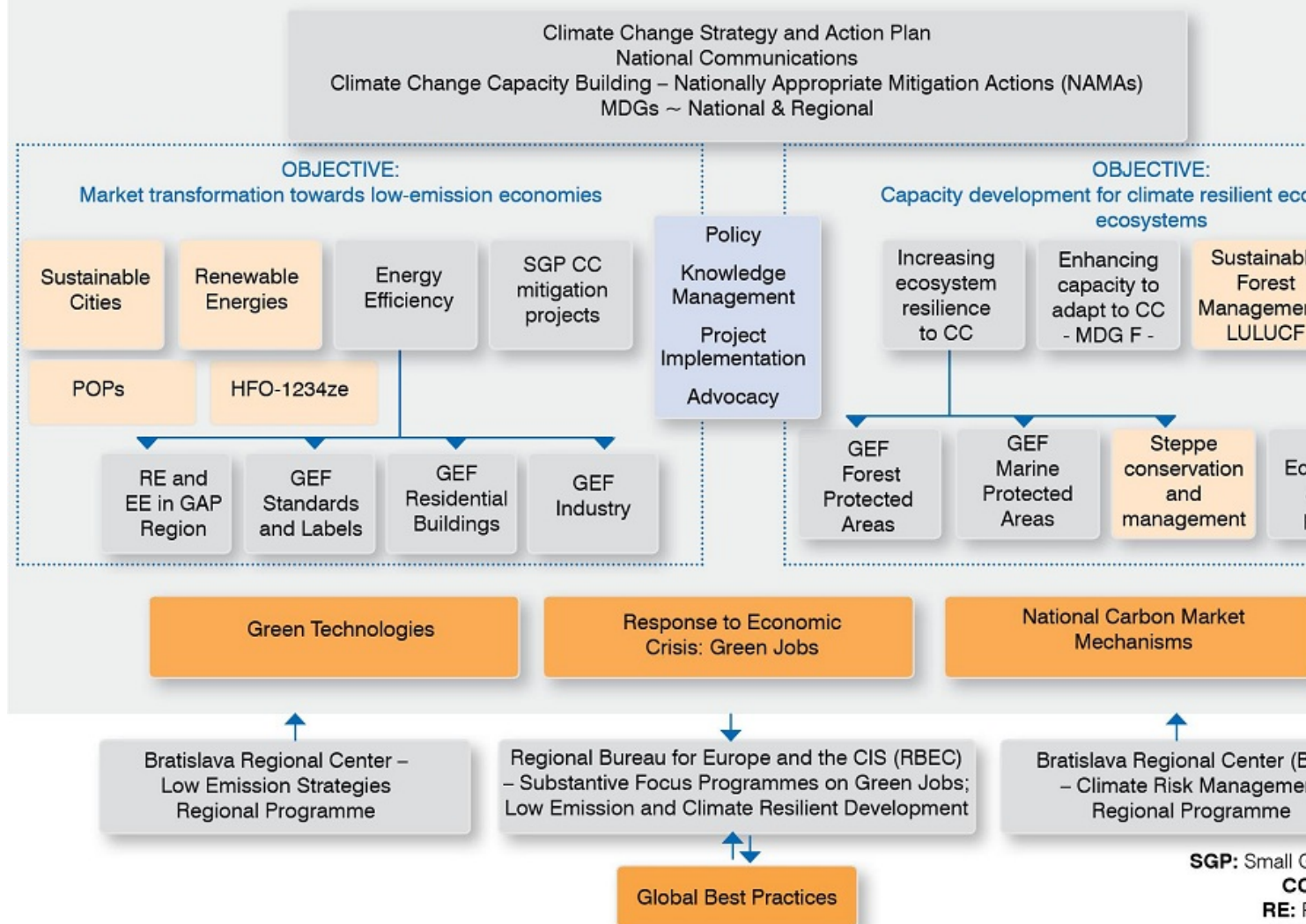


UNDP TURKEY ENVIRONMENT AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

The programme is structured around two main objectives: Market transformation towards low-emission economies and Capacity development for climate resilient ecosystems. The programme is implemented through a series of projects and activities, including Sustainable Cities, Renewable Energies, Energy Efficiency, SGP CC mitigation projects, POPs, HFO-1234ze, RE and EE in GAP Region, GEF Standards and Labels, GEF Residential Buildings, GEF Industry, Increasing ecosystem resilience to CC, Enhancing capacity to adapt to CC, Sustainable Forest Management, GEF Forest Protected Areas, GEF Marine Protected Areas, and Steppe conservation and management. The programme is supported by the Bratislava Regional Center - Low Emission Strategies Regional Programme, the Regional Bureau for Europe and the CIS (RBEC) - Substantive Focus Programmes on Green Jobs; Low Emission and Climate Resilient Development, and the Bratislava Regional Center (B) - Climate Risk Management Regional Programme.
